- Q. Does the Vice-President Customer Relations and Engineering have access for monitoring to the Transmission Asset Management System and Avantis? Do the Regional Managers provide the Vice-President with formal periodic transmission and distribution inspection and maintenance performance reports? How often?
- A. The Vice-President Customer Operations and Engineering does not monitor the
 Transmission Asset Management System and Avantis.

Transmission inspections and preventative maintenance performance are monitored by the Superintendents of Operations. On a monthly basis, the Superintendents are required to review, assess and if necessary prioritize the activities recorded in the asset management system, and report to the Regional Manager.

The Vice-President of Customer Operations and Engineering reviews the performance of the Company's maintenance activities with Regional Managers on a regular basis. This review will include a status update for maintenance activities, along with progress to date on the capital maintenance program, plus reliability data to provide a comprehensive picture of maintenance activities and performance.² While this is typically done on a quarterly basis, it is done more frequently when required.

For these quarterly reviews formal periodic transmission and distribution inspection and maintenance performance reports are not typically produced.
