 limitations. The majority of the replacements were due to the installation of additional
 power transformers in substations.
- A preliminary review shows that 1 Newfoundland Power circuit breaker at Oxen Pond
 Terminal Station will need to be replaced in 2017 prior to the integration of Muskrat Falls
 and the Labrador-Island Link. A more detailed analysis is required prior to the
 Company's 2017 Capital Budget submission to confirm this requirement.
