Re: The Board's Investigation and Hearing into Supply Issues and Power Outages on the Island Interconnected System – Phase Two Requests for Information

On March 20, 2015, Newfoundland Power filed an application (the "Application") requesting an order of the Board compelling Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") to file full and adequate responses to requests for information ("RFIs") NP-NLH-004, NP-NLH-005 and NP-NLH-018. Following consideration of the Application, the Board, on May 8, 2015, issued Order No. P.U. 13 (2015) requiring that Hydro provide responses to NP-NLH-005 and NP-NLH-018 in accordance with the Board's findings in the Order.

As of this writing, Hydro has not provided responses to NP-NLH-005 and NP-NLH-018 as ordered by the Board.

By letter dated May 11, 2015, the Board advised participants in the Investigation that it had set Monday, June 1, 2015 as the deadline for submission of the 2nd round of Phase Two RFIs.

As Newfoundland Power advised the Board in its letter dated November 24, 2014, we anticipate issuing additional RFIs in Phase Two, but not until we and our expert have had an opportunity to review Hydro's responses to our initial RFIs. Those initial RFIs, which included NP-NLH-005 and NP-NLH-018, were first submitted on September 19, 2014.

In that regard, by copy of this letter Newfoundland Power requests that Hydro provide the outstanding responses at the earliest opportunity, so we are able to file any supplementary RFIs in accordance with the current schedule.

We trust the foregoing is found to be in order.
