
Re: Combined Applications - Installation of Diesel Units at Holyrood for the Purposes of Black Starting the Generating Units and Supply, and Install 100 MW (Nominal) of Combustion Turbine Generation – Requests for Information

Further to the Board's letter of May 21, 2014, Hydro notes that there have been a very large number of Requests for Information filed on these matters, many of which are technical and complex. The resources within Hydro who will be needed to provide information and to prepare these responses are fully engaged in preparing information for the Outage Inquiry, for Hydro's annual capital budget due at the end of July, and for Hydro's presently challenging capital program. Additional time will therefore be required to ensure that a sufficient opportunity exists to provide full responses to these requests. Hydro, therefore, requests an extension until July 25, 2014 for the filing of responses to these Requests for Information.
