This is intended to be 10 addressed in the assessment currently underway by Haldar & Associates Inc. The report, titled 11 "Reliability Assessment of LIL Considering Climatological Loads," is being completed by Haldar & 12 Associates Inc. and will be filed as part of Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro's 2020 Update to 13 14 the Reliability and Resource Adequacy Study in November 2020. 15 By completing this assessment, it will be possible to determine the risk/criticality of the line 16 components exceedance resulting in an extended outage of the line.
