	explain if not known that it was run at rated speed for two or three days with vibrations noted
	during that period.
А.	To date, Synchronous Condenser Unit 3 has been operated on several occasions at various
	speeds, including rated speed, for trouble shooting and vibration signature purposes. In January
	2020, the unit was run for approximately three days continuously while synchronized to the
	grid. At that time vibration levels were above specified levels but at no point did they exceed
	alarm levels. The Lower Churchill Project's external experts determined the vibration levels to be
	within acceptable tolerances for the short amount of time the unit was operating and would
	have no risk of equipment damage.
