As part of the 9 ongoing Reliability and Resource Adequacy Study Review proceeding, Hydro has recently completed an assessment of options to improve the suitability of Holyrood TGS as a backup 10 11 facility for the Island Interconnected System, consistent with Liberty's recommendations. Should the regulatory proceedings and operational experience with the Muskrat Falls project assets 12 determine that back up supply is necessary and further assessment of the Holyrood TGS 13 14 determine that modifications can be undertaken to enable Holyrood TGS to serve as a backup facility, Hydro will include Holyrood TGS as a resource option at that time. 15
