Q. Please outline how rate adjustments associates with hydro's RSP, CDM and Project Cost 1 2 Recovery riders will be updated, or discontinued, moving forward. 3 4 Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") will continue to file the application for annual 5 A. 6 July 1 Rate Stabilization Plan ("RSP") and Conservation and Demand Management rate 7 adjustments in accordance with the approved rules of the deferral accounts. Given the uncertainty in the timing of the completion of its next general rate application ("GRA"), Hydro 8 9 anticipates updates to the Project Cost Recovery Rider to be included in these annual rate 10 applications. 11 As indicated in Hydro's response to PUB-NLH-009 of this proceeding, the implementation and 12 updating of Project Cost Recovery Riders as part of the annual RSP rate adjustment process is a practical and efficient approach to deal with gradually increasing the recovery of Muskrat Falls 13 14 Project costs from customers in advance of the implementation of final rates at the conclusion 15 of Hydro's next GRA.
