

**Q. Reference: Application**

What is the all-in average rate for all end-use customers on the Island Interconnected System?  
What is the current rate for residential customers on the Island Interconnected System, both all-in and energy charge only? What is the all-in and energy charge rate forecast for residential customers on the Island Interconnected System for July 2026?

**A.** The average all-in rate for Domestic and General Service customers is more appropriately sourced from Newfoundland Power Inc. as the primary retail provider of such service on the Island Interconnected System.

Table 1 provides the Energy Only rates for each customer class on the Island Interconnected System as of July 1, 2025, along with the average all-in rates for Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro's Industrial customers and for domestic customers based on available information. The information required to provide a forecast of 2026 rates is unavailable at this time.
