

1 Q. **Reference: Order 37(2019), Chapter 6, page 6.3**

2 As part of the Settlement Agreement in 2019 parties agreed that the single coincident peak
3 approach shall continue to be used in the cost allocation of production/generation demand
4 costs and transmission among customer classes. Hydro agreed to further review the
5 contribution of different customer classes to the uncertainty parameters in its planning studies
6 (e.g. P50 vs P90) and file a report with its next General Rate Application.

7 a) Confirm whether the report contemplated by the Settlement Agreement has been filed
8 as part of this proceeding.

9 b) If yes, identify the document, exhibit or schedule in which the report is contained.

10 c) If no, explain why the report has not been filed and indicate when Hydro intends to
11 complete and file the review.

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14 A. The referenced report was included as Schedule 1, Attachment 2 to Newfoundland and
15 Labrador Hydro's application for approval of modifications to the Cost of Service Methodology,
16 filed with the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities on August 22, 2025.¹
