1 **PUB-NLH-001** On page 9, lines 4-6 of Order No. P.U. 27(2022), the Board stated the following:

PUB-NLH-002 In Tables 3 and 5 of Schedule 1 of the Application, Hydro has indicated that Regulated Hydro's estimated share of the remaining net book value of the JDE E1 and the IM assets proposed to move to Regulated Hydro will be 57%.

- On page 23 of Schedule 1, lines 6-9 Hydro states that over the life of the JDE E1 asset, Hydro's regulated business segment share is forecast to be 54%. On page 12, lines 6-7 of Appendix D, it explains that Hydro's share of the JDE E1 additional functionalities is approximately 56%, whereas Table 2 on page 13 of Appendix D indicates 57% for the additional functionalities, excluding the dedicated costs.
- On page 25 of Schedule 1, lines 3-4 Hydro states that over the life of the IM asset, Hydro's regulated business segment share is forecast to be 53%.

Please clarify why there are differences in the percentages noted above.
