Work identified in the Rebuild Distribution Lines project is 9 only completed as part of the *Reconstruction* project under exceptional circumstances. 10 Newfoundland Power's asset management system does not track work identified for the Rebuild Distribution Lines project that is subsequently completed as part of the 11 12 *Reconstruction* project.¹ 13
