- 5 A. Newfoundland Power does not have access to data on transmission and distribution  
 6 (“T&D”) operating and maintenance costs of other Canadian Electricity Association  
 7 (“CEA”) Region 2 utilities. This data is not publicly available.  
 8
- 9 Table 1 extends the table referenced in this question to provide the aggregate capital  
 10 investment in T&D assets for other major distribution utilities in CEA Region 2.

<sup>2</sup> The other major distribution utilities included in the analysis are Hydro Quebec, Hydro One and BC Hydro.
