## Q. (Reference Application, LED Street Lighting Replacement Plan, page 5) Please confirm that under the current program about 25% of street lights would be expected to be LED six years from now.

A. This is confirmed. Under Newfoundland Power's current installation approach, there
would be approximately 17,500 total LED street light installations by the end of 2026.<sup>1</sup>
This represents approximately 26% of all street lights in service.<sup>2</sup>
