	Advisor will assist Newfoundland Power in completing a competitive tendering process
	to obtain the services of a System Integrator. <sup>1</sup> Specifically, the Procurement Advisor will
	provide expertise and best practices in: (i) developing a Request for Proposals to obtain
	System Integrator services; and (ii) developing a methodology to evaluate vendors'
	proposals. This will ensure Newfoundland Power selects the least-cost alternative that
	meets its requirements.
