	matters.
	An auditor is appointed annually by the shareholder of Newfoundland Power at the
	Company's Annual General Meeting. The Company's auditor's primary responsibility is
	to provide an <i>Independent Auditors Report</i> to the shareholder and Board of Directors of
	Newfoundland Power on the Company's annual financial statements. Since May 2017,
	Deloitte has been appointed as auditor of Newfoundland Power. Previous to Deloitte, EX
	performed audit services for the Company from 2003 to 2017.
	As the appointment of an auditor is not at the discretion of management, Newfoundland
	Power does not tender or request proposals for auditing services. Therefore, there are no
	samples to provide.
