- 1Q.In EY's experience, how accurate have estimates been by competing CSS2implementation consultants? Is EY's \$31.6 million cost estimate valid for any3procurement advisor, rather than only itself, given that a different procurement4advisor may be selected under a competitive solicitation and resulting cost estimates5could vary accordingly.6
- A. EY does not possess such data and cannot reasonably comment on the accuracy of
 estimates prepared by competing professional services firms. Unless contracted to build
 its own cost estimate, procurement advisors will typically focus on facilitating the RFP
 process and evaluating responses. Based on our experience, the estimated costs
 developed by EY in support of Newfoundland Power's assessment and planning cost
 estimates would be accepted by a procurement advisor as reasonable.
