Q. Please inform as to Newfoundland Power's proposal to compensate ratepayers for the use of ratepayer facilities to subsidize this new business opportunity for Newfoundland Power.

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A. Electrification initiatives, including the electric vehicle charging infrastructure, are proposed based on the rate mitigating benefit provided to customers. For example, customers are forecast to receive a rate mitigating benefit of 0.5 ¢/kWh by 2034. This rate mitigating benefit is consistent with the least-cost delivery of reliable service to customers.<sup>1</sup>
