Q. Volume 1, page 2-38. List each of Newfoundland Power's current collective agreements and provide the term of each, the annual wage adjustment for each year in each agreement and any special monetary adjustments.

A. Newfoundland Power has 2 collective agreements governing its union employees represented by the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 1620 (the "IBEW"). Both collective agreements are in effect from October 1, 2017 to June 30, 2022.

The negotiated wage adjustments in both collective agreements were: 1.0% on October 1, 2017; 1.5% on January 1, 2019; 2.0% on January 1, 2020; 2.0% on January 1, 2021; and 2.25% on January 1, 2022.

 During the bargaining process, the Company and the IBEW agreed to conduct a market review of base wages for the Power System Operators ("PSOs") and PSO Lead Hands as per a Letter of Understanding dated March 13, 2019. A Memorandum of Settlement on this matter was signed on January 25, 2021. As a result, wages for PSOs and PSO Lead Hands were adjusted to the Atlantic Canadian average in accordance with the Memorandum of Settlement.¹

The PSO and PSO Lead Hand base wage rates were \$47.94 and \$51.78, respectively, effective May 6, 2019. The PSO and PSO Lead Hand base wage rates will be adjusted in accordance with the collective agreement effective January 1, 2020.
