- Q. (a) What manufacturers are available in Canada to build the proposed transformer and where are these manufacturers located?
 - (b) Has NP conducted a jurisdictional scan throughout Canada and the United States, and elsewhere, to determine the least cost option for this purchase?

 A.

(a) Newfoundland Power uses a competitive tendering process to select power transformer manufacturers. The Company invites the submission of bids from three suppliers that manufacture power transformers within Canada. These are PTI Transformers Inc. in Saskatchewan, Northern Transformer Corporation in Ontario, and Delta Star in Quebec. Bids are also invited from manufacturers with operations in the United States and internationally.

(b) No, Newfoundland Power has not conducted a jurisdictional scan throughout Canada, the United States and elsewhere to determine the least-cost option for this purchase. The Company intends to use a competitive tendering process to select the least-cost option that meets its requirements, which would include inviting bids from manufacturers available internationally.
