- 2. The Customers' residences are situated in a Cottage Area known as Northbrook Road located in Gallants near Stephenville, in the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador. The Customers consist of nine (9) residents.
- 3. A number of the Customers have requested that the Applicant provide their residences with single-phase electrical service. Provision of the requested service requires that the Applicant construct approximately 1,155 metres of single-phase line (the "Extension"). Schedule A to this Application contains a drawing of the Extension.
- 4. A contribution in aid of construction ("CIAC") of the Extension has been calculated in accordance with Clause 5(a) of the CIAC Policy: Distribution Line Extensions to Domestic Customers approved by Order No. P.U. 27 (2005), dated November 2, 2005, (the "Policy"). The CIAC thus calculated is five thousand six hundred seventeen dollars and twenty-two cents (\$5,617.22) per customer, excluding HST. Schedule B to this Application is a detailed calculation of the CIAC for the Extension.
- 5. The sum of the CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) and the Basic Investment calculated pursuant to Clause 3 is \$50,555.00 and is set out in Schedule B. Clause 10(i) of the Policy states that the Applicant shall apply to the Board for approval of all CIACs where the sum of the CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) or Clause 6(a) and the Basic and Additional Investment calculated pursuant to Clauses 3 and 4 is greater than \$50,000.
- 6. The proposed CIAC as calculated in Schedule B is necessary to ensure that the Applicant's investment in the Extension is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the detriment of the Applicant's other customers.
- 7. Communications with respect to this Application should be forwarded to the attention of Dominic Foley, Counsel to the Applicant.

8. **THE APPLICANT REQUESTS** that the Board approve, pursuant to section 41(5) of the Act, the CIAC as calculated in Schedule B to this Application.



AND WHEREAS the sum of the CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) and the Basic Investment calculated pursuant to Clause 3 is \$50,555.00 and Clause 10(i) of the Policy states that the Applicant shall apply to the Board for approval of all CIACs where the sum of the CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) or Clause 6(a) and the Basic and Additional Investment calculated pursuant to Clauses 3 and 4 is greater than \$50,000;

AND WHEREAS the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that the Applicant's investment in the Extension is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the detriment of the Applicant's other customers.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- The Board approves the Refundable CIAC of five thousand six hundred seventeen dollars and twenty-two cents (\$5,617.22), excluding HST, as calculated under the Policy to apply to Domestic Customers located in the Northbrook Road Cottage Area pursuant to section 41(5) of the Act.
- 2. The Applicant shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
