- b) Historical records of customer counts associated with Newfoundland Power's substations do not extend as far back as 1981, the year of the substation's construction. While customer count data for 1981 is unavailable, the population of the community of Greenspond was 423 in 1981 and 257 in 2021. Although population figures are not a direct proxy for customer counts, they suggest that the number of customers served by the substation was likely higher in 1981 than it is today.
- c) Prior to the construction of Greenspond Substation in 1981, the community of Greenspond was serviced by a Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro diesel generating station. Greenspond Island was electrically isolated from the island grid.
