Newfoundland Power has not completed a jurisdictional review of non-wires alternatives ("NWA") in each Canadian jurisdiction from a utility or regulator perspective. The *Canadian Energy Efficiency Scorecard* ("Scorecard") from Efficiency Canada provides a national perspective on NWA. The Scorecard is published every two years, with the most recent Scorecard published in November 2024. Newfoundland and Labrador's NWA score is consistent with New Brunswick, Alberta, and Nova Scotia and is ranked ahead of Prince Edward Island and Ouebec. ²
