Report 4.1 of Newfoundland Power's 2026 Capital Budget Application notes, "material costs in 2027 include the services of the selected consultant to design, deliver and 14 implement the solution in a manner that meets Newfoundland Power's requirements and 15 remains least cost for customers." This presentation is consistent with Newfoundland 16 Power's historical practice. 17 18 19 No costs were assigned to engineering services as this is used for internal engineering 20 resources which have not been identified as necessary for this project. Similarly, the Labour - Contract cost item is used for hourly labour associated with distribution and 21 22 transmission work, such as pole setting, deadline construction and rental of tracked carrier or "muskeg" type offroad vehicles. This is also not applicable to this project. 23
