

1 Q. (Response to CA-NLH-27) If there is an emergency supply situation in Newfoundland
2 and Labrador (i.e., owing to severe weather), what is the likelihood of the
3 emergency extending to Quebec, and to Nova Scotia and its neighbouring power
4 systems, and how will this impact the amount of power available for Newfoundland
5 and Labrador during such emergencies?

8 A. Hydro has no information to suggest that severe weather conditions in
9 Newfoundland and Labrador would extend to both of (a) Quebec and (b) Nova
10 Scotia and its neighbouring power systems, and is of the view that the likelihood of
11 a weather event causing power system interruptions in all three jurisdictions would
12 be very low.
