1	Q.	Please confirm if the contract signed November 19, 2012 contains a clause which
2		stipulates that testing of the fuel oil must be done at point of loading. If not, will
3		you undertake to have this legal requirement along with having the results of such
4		analysis satisfactory to the Buyer before shipping is confirmed?
5		
6		
7	A.	The No. 6 fuel supply contract for Holyrood includes Special Condition (SC) 1.4
8		outlining the requirement to test fuel prior to delivery as follows:
9		
10		SC 1.4
11		Seller shall provide Buyer with an Analysis of Product Quality from an independent
12		inspection service, mutually agreed upon by Buyer and Seller, prior to delivery of
13		Product to Site and the issuance of the Notice of Readiness. The analysis shall
14		contain the results of the independent inspector's analysis of the Product loaded
15		aboard the marine vessel, shall identify the inspector and shall contain Inspector's
16		certification that such Product meets the contractual specifications.
