8	A.	Hydro's response to PUB-NLH-021 aligns with the question which refers to the 2014
9		winter period. In the response the word "extended" means that a demand
10		management program was not determined to be required for the remaining 2014
11		winter period. Given the date of Hydro's response to PUB-NLH-021 being mid-
12		January, the word "timeframe" means that a demand management program could
13		not be appropriately studied at that time for the 2014 winter period of January
14		through March.
