Q. 1 Please provide copies of all studies, reports, and analyses of potential demand 2 management measures prepared internally by Hydro, and externally for Hydro, 3 since January 2005. As part of this response, please provide copies of any studies, 4 reports and analyses where consideration of potential demand management 5 measures was within the scope of a study, report or analysis of a broader issue, 6 such as for example generation planning. 7 8 9 Α. Hydro has not had any studies or reports prepared internally or externally where 10 consideration of potential demand management measures was within the scope of 11 the study or report. Hydro's studies, reports, and incentive programs have been 12 focused on energy conservation rather than demand management. The 13 Conservation and Demand Management (CDM) Potential Study, base year 2006, 14 prepared by Marbek Resource Limited is an energy conservation study, which 15 identifies energy conservation measures. Although the study does not identify 16 demand management measures, it does comment on a predicted range of demand 17 impact that the energy efficiency measures may have collectively. 18 19 When Hydro considers the requirement for demand-driven capital works, CDM is 20 considered during the decision making process. Further to Hydro's internal review 21 and the Board's ongoing review, Hydro is heightening its focus on CDM, and in

particular, will be carrying out a marginal cost study in the near future to provide

economic analysis to guide the ongoing areas of focus with respect to CDM.
