Q. 1 Provide a detailed explanation of Hydro's annual maintenance planning. In the reply 2 include whether Hydro normally plans to have all generation units available by a set date for winter load demand and, if so, what is that date. 3 4 5 6 A. Hydro's annual maintenance planning begins in the second quarter of the year prior 7 to execution with the identification of upcoming planned work. This includes: 8 preventative maintenance; 9 overhauls; 10 inspections; 11 known non-emergency corrective maintenance; and 12 capital and operating projects. 13 14 Resource requirements are identified for the known scope of work. Considerations 15 include people, materials, lead times, specialized tools and equipment. Schedules 16 are developed and outage requirements are estimated at this time as well. Outages 17 for individual generation and transmission assets are consolidated into a 18 coordinated system outage plan. Work planning continues into the execution year, 19 with the plan being iterated as details become firmer and assumptions changed to 20 ensure successful execution and continued focus on the delivery of safe, reliable 21 power. 22 23 Hydro targets to have all planned outages completed with units fully available for 24 service by December 1 in any given year. The December 1 target is adhered to 25 unless unforeseen events and issues occur.
