5	A.	Hydro, as the operator of the NL electricity system, can curtail service on the
6		Maritime Link for system reliability and other purposes, at no cost to Hydro, as
7		detailed in Section 10 of the Energy and Capacity Agreement (ECA) (provided in
8		Hydro's response to PUB-NLH-220). In the event curtailments occur, Nalcor is
9		obliged to deliver any unsupplied NS block energy at a point in the future prior to
10		the end of the ECA.
