1	Q.	Further to the response to PUB-NLH-217, page 5, lines 23-27 confirm that if the
2		Maritime Link is not available there could be a power shortfall in on the Island
3		Interconnected system of 300MW, until at least one of the poles has been restored.
4		
5		
6	A.	Hydro's response to PUB-NLH-217, page 9, lines 19-21 indicates that with the
7		Maritime Link available (assuming a 300 MW import capability and the availability
8		of a 60 MW interruptible load arrangement), there would be no shortfall
9		experienced until the 2025 peak. In the unlikely event that the Maritime Link is not
10		available at the same time there were to be an unforeseen bipole outage on the
11		Labrador-Island Link, the amount of shortfall of supply on the Island Interconnected
12		System will depend on customer demand and generation capability. However, even
13		in this scenario, it would be 2025 before any shortfall on the Island would reach 300
14		MW.
