ii.	dual policy	5%
iii.	university student living away from home, returning on seasonal breaks only	50%
iv.	university student living away from home, returning on weekends and seasonal breaks	25%

4. These rates shall be effective June 1, 2003 for new business and August 1, 2003 for renewals.
