22	WHEREAS on October 20, 2010 the Board's actuarial consultants, Oliver Wyman, filed a
23	report with the Board that identified issues with the rate proposals; and

25	WHEREAS on November 30, 2010 Security National submitted revised rate proposals to
26	address the issues raised in Oliver Wyman's October 20, 2010 report; and

28	WHEREAS on December 2, 2010 Oliver Wyman filed a report that concludes the November
29	30, 2010 rate proposals are based on factors and parameters determined by the Board to be
30	reasonable and are supported by information submitted in connection with the filing; and
