- 18 **WHEREAS** Metro has applied for rates which are less than the indicated rate levels for Third 19 Party Liability, Collision, Comprehensive and Uninsured Motorist coverages; and

- WHEREAS the Board, after due examination and analysis, has determined that the proposed rates for Third Party Liability, Collision, Comprehensive and Uninsured Motorist coverages are reasonable; and

- WHEREAS Metro has applied for rates which are higher than the indicated rate levels for
 Accident Benefits coverage and Underinsured Motorist coverage; and

- WHEREAS the Board, after due examination and analysis, has determined that the proposed rates for Accident Benefits and Underinsured Motorist coverages are too high in the circumstances.
