1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power*  
2 *Control Act, 1994*, SNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1 (the  
3 "*EPCA*") and the *Public Utilities Act*, RSNL 1990,  
4 Chapter P-47 (the "*Act*") and regulations thereunder;

6 **AND**

8 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by  
9 Newfoundland Power Inc. pursuant to  
10 Section 41 of the *Act* for the approval  
11 of a Contribution in Aid of Construction for  
12 a line extension to serve Domestic Customers  
13 in the cottage area known as Middle Three  
14 Island Pond located near the Town of Torbay.

17 **WHEREAS** Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly  
18 organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a  
19 public utility within the meaning of the *Act*, and is also subject to the provisions of the  
20 *EPCA*; and

22 **WHEREAS** on November 26, 2012 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval  
23 of a Contribution in Aid of Construction ("CIAC") for a single-phase line extension of  
24 approximately 3,152 metres (the Extension") to serve Domestic Customers in a cottage area  
25 known as Middle Three Island Pond located near the Town of Torbay; and

26  
27 **WHEREAS** twelve of twenty-one potential customers have requested that Newfoundland  
28 Power provide electrical service (the "Participating Customers"); and

29  
30 **WHEREAS** the Participating Customers have requested the Non-Refundable CIAC Option  
31 provided for in Clause 6 of Newfoundland Power's CIAC Policy; and

32  
33 **WHEREAS** the number of Participating Customers meets the minimum participation  
34 percentage of 50% required to avail of the Non-Refundable CIAC Option; and

35  
36 **WHEREAS** the Non-Refundable CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 6 of the  
37 CIAC Policy, is five thousand one hundred fifty dollars and ten cents (\$5,150.10),  
38 excluding HST; and


1 **WHEREAS** the sum of the Non-Refundable CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 6 and the  
2 Basic Investment calculated pursuant to Clause 3 exceeds \$50,000, and therefore in  
3 accordance with Clause 10(i) of the CIAC Policy Board approval is required; and

5 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power's  
6 investment is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the  
7 detriment of Newfoundland Power's other customers.


9 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

- 11 1. The Non-Refundable Contribution in Aid of Construction of five thousand one hundred
- 12 fifty dollars and ten cents (\$5,150.10), excluding HST, to apply to Domestic Customers
- 13 located in the cottage area known as Middle Three Island Pond is approved.

- 15 2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.


