- 1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Automobile*

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11 **WHEREAS** on January 24, 2013 Facility Association applied to the Board for approval of a 12 revised rating program for its Private Passenger Automobiles class of business; and

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- WHEREAS the rating program proposes rates that are higher than those currently approved bythe Board for a number of insureds; and
- WHEREAS this application is Facility Association's first Category 2 PPA filing since
 automobile insurance reforms in 2005 which prohibited the use of age, gender and marital status
 in risk classification systems; and
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- WHEREAS on March 22, 2013, May 24, 2013, August 5, 2013 and October 24, 2013 the Board's consulting actuaries, Oliver Wyman Limited, filed reports identifying key areas of interest for the Board, and these reports were copied to Facility Association; and
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- WHEREAS on March 28, 2013 the Board approved an extension of the 90-day review timeline;
 and
- 28 WHEREAS on July 18, 2013 Facility Association filed revised rate indications; and
- WHEREAS throughout the review process Facility Association provided additional information
 and commentary; and
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- 33 WHEREAS based on the record the Board finds that several of the proposals in the revised
- 34 automobile insurance rating program for Private Passenger Automobiles class of business have
- 35 not been fully justified; and

WHEREAS the Board does not accept Facility Association's approach in relation to: i) capped premiums; ii) loss trend rates; iii) the health levy; iv) return on investment; and, v) finance fee revenues; and

- 5 **WHEREAS** the Board will require Facility Association to file a revised rating program for its 6 Private Passenger Automobiles class of business incorporating the findings of the Board as set 7 out in the Reasons for Decision to be issued separately.
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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

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1. The application is denied.

- Facility Association shall submit for the approval of the Board, within 30 days of receipt of the Reasons for Decision, a revised rating program for its Private Passenger Automobiles class of business that reflects the findings of the Board as set out in the Reasons for Decision.
- 17 3. Facility Association shall report to the Board within 90 days in relation to finance fee18 revenues as set out in the Reasons for Decision.
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4. Facility Association shall pay the costs of the Board associated with this application,including the costs of the actuarial review.
