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15	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly
16	organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a
17	public utility within the meaning of the Act, and is also subject to the provisions of the
18	EPCA; and
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20	WHEREAS Pennecon Limited (the "Customer") has requested Newfoundland Power
21	provide its industrial manufacturing facility located in the Town of Bay Bulls with three-
22	phase electrical service; and
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24	WHEREAS it is necessary to upgrade 1,571 metres of an existing single-phase line to
25	three-phase standard and construct an additional 113-metre three-phase extension (the
26	"Extension") to provide the requested service; and
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28	WHEREAS on June 4, 2013 the Board received an application from Newfoundland Power
29	for approval of a contribution in aid of construction ("CIAC") to carry out the construction
30	of the three-phase distribution line extension to the industrial manufacturing facility; and
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32	WHEREAS the estimated cost of construction of the Extension is two hundred fourteer
33	thousand fifty-two dollars and forty-eight cents (\$214,052.48) and is based on a detailed
34	engineering estimate in accordance with Clause 5(e) of the CIAC Policy; Distribution Line
35	Extensions and Upgrades to General Service Customers, approved by Order No. P.U
26	27(2005) (the "Policy"); and

WHEREAS a CIAC for the Extension has been calculated in accordance with Clause 5(e) of the Policy, which calculation assumes the Extension will supply service to an industrial manufacturing facility with an estimated peak demand of 100.0kW and the CIAC thus calculated is one hundred fifty thousand one hundred ninety dollars and forty-eight cents (\$150,190.48), excluding HST; and

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WHEREAS Clause 10(ii) of the Policy states that the Newfoundland Power shall apply to the Board for approval of all line extensions or upgrades involving CIACs where the cost of the line extension or upgrade is calculated pursuant to Clause 5(e); and

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WHEREAS the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power's investment in the Extension is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the detriment of Newfoundland Power's other customers.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

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1. The Contribution in Aid of Construction of one hundred fifty thousand one hundred ninety dollars and forty-eight cents (\$150,190.48), excluding HST, as calculated under the Policy to provide three-phase electrical service to an industrial manufacturing facility in the town of Bay Bulls as requested by Pennecon Limited is approved.

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2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
