7 to implement Standard Endorsement S.E.F. 5C for its

11 **WHEREAS** on January 2, 2015 Aviva Insurance Company of Canada applied to the Board for
12 approval to implement Standard Endorsement S.E.F. 5C for its Commercial Vehicles class of
13 business; and

15 **WHEREAS** Standard Endorsement S.E.F. 5C is an optional endorsement which gives
16 permission to rent or lease vehicles to unspecified lessees for a period not in excess of 30 days;

19 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are not too high in the circumstances.
