- WHEREAS on June 8, 2016 Facility Association filed comments in response to the Oliver
 Wyman report; and

- WHEREAS on June 23, 2016 the Board advised Facility Association that the 90-day timeline
 for review of the filing had been extended to allow for adequate time to review the rating
 program; and

- WHEREAS on June 23, 2016 the Board provided a response to Facility Association's comments
 on the Oliver Wyman report; and

- WHEREAS based on the record the Board finds that some proposals used by Facility
 Association in calculating its rate level indications have not been fully justified; and

- WHEREAS the Board accepts Facility Association's proposals for its Garage rating program
 with the exception of the full credibility standards; and
- 36 WHEREAS substituting alternative assumptions for the full credibility standards will not reduce
- 37 the rate indications below the proposed rates; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are not too high in the circumstances.
