19 WHEREAS on December 3, 2019 the Board's actuarial consultants, Oliver Wyman Limited 20 ("Oliver Wyman"), filed a report ("Oliver Wyman Report") of findings with the Board which 21 identified key areas of the filing for the Board's consideration; and

- WHEREAS on December 4, 2019 the Oliver Wyman Report was forwarded to Facility for

26 WHEREAS on December 12, 2019 Facility filed an amended rate application; and

- WHEREAS on December 13, 2019 Oliver Wyman reported that the amended rate application
 received from Facility on December 12, 2019 was consistent with prior Board decisions for
- 30 Facility rate applications for its Private Passenger Automobiles class of business; and

- 32 WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are not too high in the circumstances.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The revised rating program received December 12, 2019 from Facility Association for its Private Passenger Automobiles class of business is approved to be effective no sooner than April 1, 2020 for new business and renewals.

2. Facility Association will be required to pay the costs of the Board associated with this filing, including the costs of the actuarial review.
