13 **WHEREAS** on October 2, 2020 Security National Insurance Company (“Security National”) applied to the Board for approval of a revised rating program under the Mandatory Simplified filing option for its Motorcycles class of automobile insurance, effective February 1, 2021 for new business and renewals; and

18 **WHEREAS** Security National does not have sufficient volume to perform an actuarial analysis for Motorcycles; and

21 **WHEREAS** Security National conducted an internal analysis and determined that a rate change was not warranted; and

24 **WHEREAS** Security National proposed no additional rating program changes; and

26 **WHEREAS** the Board finds that the proposal is made in accordance with the Board’s Mandatory Simplified Filing Guidelines and is supported; and

29 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the *Automobile Insurance Act* or the *Insurance Companies Act* or the respective regulations thereunder.


1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**
