13	WHEREAS on July 3, 2020 Co-operators General Insurance Company ("Co-operators") applied

for its Private Trailers class of automobile insurance, effective November 18, 2020 for new business and January 2, 2021 for renewals; and

to the Board for approval of a revised rating program under the Mandatory Simplified filing option

WHEREAS Co-operators filed an overall rate level indication of 33.5% and proposed an overall rate level change of 16.7%; and

WHEREAS Co-operators noted that it only proposed half of its calculated rate level indication, subject to rounding, due to the small book of business for Private Trailers, the low credibility of the company's own experience and the heavy influence that industry data had on the indication; and

WHEREAS the Board finds that the proposal is made in accordance with the Board's Mandatory Simplified Filing Guidelines and is supported; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the *Automobile Insurance Act* or the *Insurance Companies Act* or the respective regulations thereunder.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

IN THE MATTED OF the Automobile

1. The proposal received July 3, 2020 from Co-operators General Insurance Company for its Private Trailers class of automobile insurance is approved to be effective no sooner than November 18, 2020 for new business and January 2, 2021 for renewals.
