<u>Heating Fuels</u> <u>Maximum Tank Wagon (or ** Tank Farm) Prices - Effective January 30, 2005</u>

In accordance with the provisions of "The Petroleum Products Act", Chapter P-10.1, Section 4, Newfoundland and Labrador Statutes the following notice re petroleum prices is issued:

Commencing 12:01 a.m., Sunday, January 30, 2005, the maximum tank wagon and tank farm prices to be charged for the listed petroleum products appearing in the Table below (in cents per litre) plus H.S.T., are effective for all pricing zones identified within the Table, and continuing until such time as changes are made by the Board. Dealers may price at or below the listed prices in the specified zones, but may not exceed the listed prices stated within the Table.
